The 16th Street Mall was rated the **Number 1**Attraction in the Entire Denver Metro Area and has the highest average pedestrian traffic of any street in the entire State of Colorado. Showcase your work in front of thousands of interested buyers in the center of the biggest city in the Rocky Mountain region. The 16th Street Mall is Denver's most significant public space -- it is one of our city's most powerful economic engines thanks to its 200 street-



level retailers and restaurants, 22,000 residents, and 130,000 employees; and claims international significance as one of the largest pedestrian and transit corridor of its kind in the world.

Details:

The 13th annual 16th Street Fair is a premier art and craft festival. The 16th Street Fair is an extremely popular event held twice a year in the heart of Downtown Denver! The Fair will take place on Saturdays & Sundays on July 31 & August 1 and also on October 23 & 24.

The Fair will run through the center of Downtown Denver spread over approximately 4 Blocks in one of the busiest sections of the vibrant 16th Street Mall. The 16th Street Fair is the only art and craft fair of the year that happen on on the 16th Street Mall.

The 16th Street Fair has been ranked as one of the "Top Craft Shows in Denver" by CBS news

Where:

The 16th Street Fair is located along the median of the Historic 16th Street Mall.

The event will span the several blocks of the 16th Street Mall from California to Tremont, which is near or in front of the Denver Pavilions. Exhibitor spaces are outdoors. This highly visible location will put you in front of several 1000s of visitors. Over 45,000 pedestrians a day cruise this tree lined pedestrian promenade that spans the center of Downtown Denver.

The 16th Street Mall is currently rated the **Number 1** Attraction in the Entire Denver Metro Area, and is the place to be for locals and tourists! The Fairs will take place during the height of the busy summer tourist season.

How to be an exhibitor:

You are cordially invited to submit your application for this premier art and craft show.

Artists may submit an application for original items and work that is handmade.

Categories of exhibitors include Art Glass, Fine Art, Folk Art, Furniture, Gift Baskets, Gourmet prepackaged specialty foods, Handmade Clothing, Handmade Toys, Jewelry, Metal Work, Upcycle, Photography, Pottery, Sculpture, Textiles/Fiber, Wood Products, and Much More!

All items & work displayed at this juried show must be handmade art or craft!

Prepacked craft food items are acceptable, but there will be no food or drink vendors permitted at this event. All vendors are required to either use table clothes or skirting around their display tables.

The application process:

This is an Art and Craft Festival so all work sold must be of original design and all items must be handmade. In order to participate, you will need to fill out an application. There are 2 ways to apply:

1. **Apply Online** - This is the most popular way to apply and is what you should choose if you prefer to pay by credit card, debit card or PayPal. The online application found at the top menu of the website www.coloradoevents.net or www.16thstfair.com

All online applications will be juried about 2 to 3 times a month on an ongoing basis. You should know the outcome of you application within 2 weeks of applying if not sooner. Online Applicants will be notified of their acceptance into the show via email. Upon acceptance you will also receive an invoice to pay the exhibitor fee with Paypal or any credit card of your choice.

2. **Apply through the mail** – Choose this option if you prefer to pay by check. The paper application is attached to this document. Please return the paper application to us via the mail. Please also include 2 checks <u>made payable to Colorado Events</u> and be send it to:

If you choose to sign up with a paper application you have the option to mail us photos of you work. All paper applications should include two checks: a \$20 (Single Event) or \$25 (Multiple Event) non-refundable application fee and a separate check for the appropriate vendor fee. All paper applications will be juried twice a month and email notification of acceptance will be given out shortly thereafter. If you want to speed up the jurying process, you should apply online. We will notify all applicants of their acceptance decision via email. If you are accepted into the show then we will email you and also cash your 2nd check for the vendor fee. If you are not accepted we will shred the 2nd check. You can optionally include a postage paid, pre addressed envelope if you prefer to have the 2nd check returned to you or if you want us to return the jury photos that you sent us.



Jurying

The one time \$20 jury fee is the same regardless if you are applying for 1, 2, 3 or all 4 event dates of the 16th Street Fair. We also offer a multiple event jury fee of \$25. If you choose the multiple jury fee option, then you can apply to as many juried events that Colorado Events produces in 2021 for one low jury fee. The cost to apply is the \$20 or \$25 jury application fee. The 2 day vendor fee is due 30 days from the date of being notified of acceptance into the show. Should your acceptance date fall within 30 days or less of the event dates, then you will be expected to pay the vendor fee within 7 days of notification of acceptance.

A jury entry will be judged for eligibility based upon quality, originality and presentation. We are looking for distinctive high quality craftsmanship and unique art and crafts. Our curation process will ensure an appropriate balance for the entire show, when determining the number of artists invited for each medium.

Affordable Exhibitor Fees - All exhibitor booths are 10' x 10' and you are expected to bring your own canopy tent and tent weights. If you don't have your own tent, we will be renting a limited number of canopy tents for \$25 a day.


Other Information

Categories of products and services will be limited. This will permit the products being sold to be diverse and non-competitive. We also reserve the right to deny booth sharing in certain situations. There is no additional fee to share a space, but both parties are subject to approval.

Booths spaces are assigned by Colorado Events with the highest priority locations being assigned in the order that your application is received and this event sells out quickly every year, so don't delay in registering. Booth assignments will be email to you prior to the event dates. Please be prepared for Colorado's variable weather conditions. Overnight security will not be provided at this event and vendors will be required to take down their booths at the end of each day of the Fair. You will be able to drive on the Mall and temporarily park at your space for set up and take down. Your exhibitor fee does not cover the cost of parking in Downtown Denver.
